

You can edit, delete, or add new homework categories to fit your needs.



You can **drag the rows up and down** to be placed in any specific order. This order will be copied to the payroll entry sheets, allowing you to keep all forms consistent.







Name the homework category with a title you will easily recognize. Ex: Weekly Review Quiz






The **Calculation Type** determines if it is an income or a fine.
The Quiz is an income,
so use the pull down menu to choose that option.

Value is the amount of money the assignment is worth. This part can be a little confusing, so let me explain in more detail...

Edit Homework Types

When you enter Payroll each week:

If the value is $> \$1.00$, it becomes a credit/no credit assignment worth that value amount.

If the value is $= \$1.00$, then I can enter the score they received on the assignment.

*Any assignment you want to be able to give partial credit for will need to have a value of $\$1.00$.

Edit Homework Types

When you enter Payroll each week:

If the value is > \$1.00, it becomes a credit/no credit assignment worth that value amount.

When my students do their Daily Warmup, I give them credit for the effort; I don't dock them for errors. If they do the warmup all five days of class, I would enter a 5 in this category. $5 \times \$15.00 = \75.00 .

Edit Homework Types

When you enter Payroll each week:

If the value is = \$1.00, then I can enter the score they received on the assignment.

When my students do a project, I give them a score.

Wesley earned an \$85.00 on this week's project.

I would enter an **85** in this category.


$$85 \times \$1.00 = \$85.00.$$

I am going to set the Value of my Weekly Review Quiz as **\$1.00**.

Note: the actual quiz is worth a possible \$10.00. But with the value set at \$1.00, I can give them credit for their correct answers only, instead of having to give full credit.




